(3) Letters of recommendation: One letter must come from a guidance counselor (or principal if counselor is unavailable), one letter must come from a STEM teacher, and one letter must come from an unrelated adult such as: an employer, athletic coach, mentor, family friend, clergy person, et cetera. Letters cannot be from family members. It is important to choose people to write letters who know you well, who are familiar with your internship interests and goals, who can give details about your disposition, aptitude, your level of professionalism and independence, and your personal & academic achievements. Letters of recommendation should be directly submitted to Sarah Holbrooke (sarah@pinheadinstitute.org) in PDF form, labeled with your first and last name like this: John Smith LOR
